To: Chief Executive of each Education and Training Board

Revised Domestic Subsistence Allowances effective from 1st September 2022 Payable to Staff in Education and Training Boards (ETBs) and Members of ETBs and of ETB Statutory Committees

INTRODUCTION

Following a review by the Minister of Public Expenditure and Reform of the domestic subsistence allowances in accordance with agreed recommendations made by the General Council under the Scheme of Conciliation and Arbitration for the Civil Service, I am directed by the Minister for Education to inform you of changes to the rates of travel and subsistence allowances which are payable to:

- (1) Staff in Education and Training Boards (ETBs) and
- (2) Members of ETBs and of ETB Statutory Committees.

ETBs are reminded that travel and subsistence expenditure is subject to approved limits. It is a matter for each ETB to ensure compliance with its budgetary limits and the Chief Executive should continue to ensure that only essential travel is undertaken and that the number of officers/members on any official journey is kept to the absolute minimum.

ETBs should ensure that all possible economies are secured in expenditure in respect of travel both at home and abroad.

Travel should be by public transport where possible. Where conveyance by rail or bus is practicable, the allowance to be paid will be the actual expenses of travel. Where the use of an officer/member's private vehicle is necessary, mileage allowances may be paid in line with the rates notified in this circular.

Revised Standard Domestic Subsistence Rates

1. The revised standard rates of subsistence allowance in Ireland are specified in the schedule at Appendix 1.
2. The following changes will be made to the overnight rate with effect from 1st September 2022. The overnight rate will increase from €147 to €167.



3. In accordance with the agreed procedures and in line with changes to the Consumer Price Index (CPI) the standard 5 & 10 Hour rates are not being increased. Changes to these rates are based upon the changes in “eating out” elements of the Consumer Price Index (CPI). Changes in this category are reviewed for the period from March to March and, where the percentage change exceeds 5%, rates are revised.
4. Future arrangements covering all travel and subsistence payments will include a mechanism for reductions in rates to reflect any future downturn of the relevant CPI element

Vouched Accommodation (“VA”) Rate for Dublin

5. A Vouched Accommodation (VA) rate continues to apply where officers/members encounter difficulties in sourcing suitable accommodation in Dublin within the standard rate.
6. In such cases, a Vouched Accommodation Rate will remain the vouched costs of accommodation up to a limit of the standard overnight rate (€167.00) plus €39.08.
7. In accordance with existing policy, where an officer/member sources accommodation that exceeds the cost of the standard overnight rate or vouched accommodation rate as appropriate, they will be solely responsible for meeting the additional accommodation expense. Officers’/members’ attention is drawn to Paragraph 3 of Circular 11/1982: Travelling and Subsistence Regulations which states that the ‘subsistence allowance payable is not intended to meet the whole cost of subsistence’.
8. The standard Overnight rate will continue to apply where officers/members source accommodation and meals in Dublin within the rate. Where officers/ members cannot source accommodation within this rate, they may claim the VA rate. Accommodation costs while claiming the VA rate must be vouched.

DATE OF IMPLEMENTATION FOR THE REVISED ARRANGEMENTS

The implementation date for the revised rates of subsistence allowances for members of ETBs, members of ETB statutory committees and all staff employed by ETBs, including those on leave of absence, is the 1st September 2022.



GENERAL

Payment of rates authorised in this Circular are subject to Circular 11/82 and any other instruction in force from time to time, including the distance requirements outlined in DPER Circular 05/2015: Subsistence Allowances.

In relation to members of ETBs and ETB statutory committees, the existing arrangements for school boards of management and Audit and Finance Committees will continue to apply, as follows:

- Subsistence allowances will not be payable to members of boards of management for attendance at board of management meetings. However, schools may provide tea/coffee and light refreshments, if authorised by the Board, from petty cash.
- External members of an Audit or Finance Committee who are in receipt of a fee for attendance at the Audit or Finance Committee are not entitled to claim travel and subsistence expenses.

Please ensure that copies of this circular are brought to the attention of all members of ETBs, members of ETB statutory committees and all staff employed by ETBs, including those on leave of absence.
